In Annual General Body Meeting, It was decided by house unanimously that all the new guide line (by Ministry of Sports, Govt. of India time to time) adopted in Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India with immediate effect and amendment in constitution also.

According new guideline amended in constitution from 29th Jan. 2011 as under.

a- Any office bearer of federation or state units, age limit not more then 70 year.

✓ b- Office bearer should be a sports person/ sports organizes/ sports lover/ broad knowledge in sports and also should be a Indian person.

c- Gen. Secretary of federation, Vice President and Treasurer 2 term 4+4 only 8 year can take place. Any new person elected for next term for these post (it is good for the promotion of game) President of the federation should be maximum three year term (12 years) only new President elected after three tenure/ after one tenure (4 year) end the President and Secretary may be elected for next tenure.

d- All the affiliated units/ state take decision accordingly, for the promotion of game. (not any govt. of India guideline for state unit regarding two tenure but also do it)

It was amendment in constitution of TBCFI & Pass unanimously.

CONSTITUTION

MEMORANDUM

2011

1. NAME

The name of the Federation shall be TENNIS BALL CRICKET FEDERATION OF INDIA.

2. OFFICE

The registered office of the Federation shall be normally where its Hony. Secretary resides, at present and it is behind Head Post office, Main Bazar, Gorakhpur, U.P. (INDIA).

3. JURISDICTION :

The jurisdiction of Federation shall be hole of the country as defined in the constitution of India.

4. AIMS AND OBJECT :

- (a) To promote, encourage and assist in the development of Tennis Ball Cricket (for men and women) India.
- (b) To control and regulate Tennis Ball Cricket at amateur basis for men and women (boys and girls) in India.
- (c) To find ways and means to encourage the continuous training of competitors to participate in National, Asian and International recognized competition.
- (d) To conduct National and International Tennis Ball Cricket Tournament in India for men and women.
- (e) To send Indian team to play abroad and to invite foreign teams to play in India.
- (f) To prepare National and International level officials for the Federation.
- (g) To affiliate State, Union Territory, Regions, Inter-Varsity, Board, Services Railways etc. with instructions of Ministry of Sports.
- (h) To raise funds for the Federation by every legal means.
- (i) To provide coaches for the affiliated units.
- (j) To do all such other acts as may be necessary to further the interest of the Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India.
- (k) To conduct National, International, Inter Zonal Tournaments, through Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India.
- (l) To control all the Tennis Ball Cricket activities in India on pure armature basis.
- (m) To maintain affiliation with the Asian and International Federation.

5. PATRON:

Persons of eminence residing in India be a Patron of the Federation contributing a minimum of Rs.5000 to the fund of the Federation may be called a Patron.

6. FOUNDER MEMBER :

The units those who participate in the first National Tennis Ball Cricket Championship, they enjoyed the membership of Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India There Secretaries shall be known as the founder member of the Federation. They will be treated as V.I.P.'s in every tournament in India.

POWER OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL:

- (i) To hold meeting for disposal of business of Federation.
 (ii) To elect office bearers and member of the Executive Committee once in four year consisting of the following:-

- a) President
- b) Chairman
- c) Vice President (not more than five)
- d) Hony. Secretary
- e) Convener
- f) Hony. Treasurer
- g) Joint Secretary (not more than five)
- h) Executive Committee (not more than five)

All the office bearer shall be elected by the General Council.

8. SOME AMENDMENT OF BEARERS (ELECTION PROCESSOR)

- a) Any office bearer of federation or state units, age limit not more than 70 year.
- b) Office bearer should be a sports person/sports organizes/sports lover/broad knowledge in sports and also should be a Indian person.
- c) Gen. Secretary of Federation, Vice-President and Tresurer-2 term 4+4 only 8 year can take place. Any new person elected for next term for these post (it is good for the promotion of game) president of the federation should be maximum three year term (12 years) only new President elected after three tenure/after one tenure (4 year) end the President and Secretary may be elected for next tenure. The age of office bearers of the Federation & state Association should not be more than 70 years.
- d) All the affiliated units/state takes decision accordingly, for the promotion of game. It was amendment in constitution of TBCFI & Pass unanimously.

9.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- i) To control the general policy of the federation
- ii) To elect an Auditor
- iii) To decide all matters pertaining to affiliation, its decision shall be final
- iv) To hold meeting for the disposal of the business.
- v) To hold, control and administration the properties and funds of the Federation.
- vi) To elect representative for the Asian and International Federation.
- vii) To scrutinize and pass the budget of Income and expenditure and Annual report and to forward the same to General Council.
- viii) To arrange tour outside the country for the participations in the Tournaments, Coaching and clinics and exhibition matches.

10.

DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:**PRESIDENT:**

- a) The President shall preside over the General Council as well as Executive Committee meetings.
- b) The activities of the Federation shall be carried under the supervision of the President.

CHAIRMAN

Chairman next to the President. The Chairman shall president the Federation meeting in the absence of President.

HONY. SECRETARY

The Hony. Secretary shall be the responsible person for carrying out the decision of the council, the Executive Committee and various committee and shall carry on the general business of TENNIS BALL MARKET FEDERATION OF INDIA, including the minutes of the meeting calling of the meeting and enforcing the rules of the Federation shall exercise control and supervise on all financial matters, would for the promotion of the objects of Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India and will works on behalf of the Federation.

HONY. TREASURE:

The Treasurer shall assist the Hony. Secretary in carrying out the business of the Federation. He/She will be responsible for having the accounts of the Income and Expenditure of the Federation.

HONY. JOINT SECRETARY:

The Joint Secretary will assist the Hony. Secretary in carrying out the business of the Federation and shall perform such function as may be entrusted by the Executive Committee. In case the Hony. Secretary is absent for more than one month, the Executive Committee or president to depute one Jt. Secretary work as the Hony. Secretary.

11. FINANCIAL YEAR:

The financial year of the Federation shall be from 1st of April to 31st March.

12. MEETING:

The general council meeting of the Federation shall be held normally during the National Championship. The notice of the meeting shall be issued atleast 15 days before the date fixed for the meeting, and the agenda together with the necessary enclosures shall be circulated atleast 05 days before the meeting.

All resolutions to be moved at the meeting must reach to the Hony. Secretary atleast seven days before the meeting.

A special meeting of the Federation shall be called either by the president or upon receipt of a requisition signed by not less than 1/3 affiliated units. The notice of such special meeting shall be issued atleast 15 days before the date of the meeting together with the resolution to be moved at the meeting and the name of the proposers thereof.

The Executive Committee of the Federation shall meet atleast once a year.


Urgent business which cannot wait for the meeting shall be circulated to the members for the opinion which must reach the Hony. Secretary within 10 days from the date of circulation, such opinion shall be laid before the president who shall decide the matter on the basis of these opinions. Such decision shall be entered in the minutes book and shall be confirmed in the next meeting.

13. QUORUM :

The quorum of a meeting, the general council shall be 14 and for the Executive committee be nine. No quorum shall be necessary at any adjourned meeting either of the general council or the Executive committee.

If any meeting is adjourned for want of quorum, the Hony. Secretary shall issue fresh notice in accordance with the rules and no quorum shall be necessary for such meeting.

Two hours notice shall be enough for the adjourned meeting.

14. FORCE OF RULES :

Every member of the Federation shall be bound to confirm to the rules, regulation and bye-laws of the Federation, which may from time to time be enforce.

15. LADIES REPRESENTATION :

Two vice-President and two Joint Secretary must be a lady. The number may be increased, if necessary.

16. VOTING RIGHT :

Voting at a meeting shall be determined by the majority of votes those present and voting. The Chairman of the meeting shall have the power to exercise a casting vote. No proxy shall be allowed. No defaulters shall be allowed to vote.

17. ACCOUNTS :

The accounts of the Federation shall be opened in nationalized Bank which will jointly operated by the convener/secretary and treasurer.

18. AMENDMENTS :

No rules of the Federation shall be replaced, aided to, amended or altered except by two third majority or those represent and entitled to vote.

19. BYE LAWS:

a) The Executive Committee shall decide Annual Fees, Registration Fees, Tournaments Fees, at present it is Rs.800 as affiliation Fees, Rs.300 Annual Fees and Rs.10/- per head as player Registration Fees, Entry for National Rs.200/-, All India Tournament Rs.5,000/-, Capitation Fees and for National Rs.10,000/- and for Inter Zonal Tournament Rs.5,000.00. This amount to pay the Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India.

b) Male and Female players be allowed to participate in the tournaments.
A unit or player may be debarred to play in a unrecognized match. If a player is transferred from one to another place they must take clearance from their previous unit.

A player may be debarred from the Federation on the basis of misbehavior or misconduct.

c) The whole country shall be divided into South, North, East, West and Central Zones. The executive Committee will select a Zonal Chairman and Convener. They will conduct Zonal League and shall responsible to select their zonal team to participate in the Inter Zonal Tournament.

d) An International match will be allotted to only those who will fulfill the condition of the Executive Committee of the Federation.

e) The team who will be not participated in the sub-junior and junior Nationals they will not be invited for the senior National also.

f) If any executive member or office bearer except president failed to attend two association meeting in a row, he/she forfeit their membership automatically. The President will be exempted for three meetings in a row.

g) The Federation will depute umpires, arrange fixture, and look into the other technical matters and host state will not interfere in these matters.

h) If a team present in a Nationals, refuse to play due to any reason or leaves the venue the next best team available will be asked to play and action will be taken against the team which will refuse to play by the disciplinary committee.

i) Age for junior player shall be 19 years on 31st December of the year in which they will participate in the sub-junior, 16 years on 31st December. A head of the institution or a magistrate or a Gazetted Officer will certify the age and certificate should be counter signed by the State Secretary.

20. SUB COMMITTEE :

- (i) There will be selection committee and technical committee for the federation. The president and secretary shall be ex-officials in the all committee.
- (ii) Any dispute in any state units and federation or any Tournaments, the Arbitration Committee will take decision, with five members of committee and President and Secretary will be ex-officials.
- (iii) Disciplinary Committee will take action against the team, players, officials, affiliated units or an individual who will break the rules and harm the Federation cause. The President and Secretary will be the ex-officio of the Committee and three member more in the Committee.

21. ALLOTMENT OF NATIONAL :

In General Body meeting take decision for the nationals Championship. The Federation may give National events to any Govt. or Private agency. if a state unit cannot conduct an event.

22. RULES :

Only Tennis Ball Cricket Federation of India rule be adopted in Tournaments.
